On The Orientation Programme for Freshers2022-23

Orientation Programme for the students admitted to the college for first B.Sc and BCA programmes during the Academic year 2022-23 was organised for two days from 26-09-2022 to 27-09-2022. The program happened in two parallel sessions. To begin with, students were insisted to attend orientation programme by sending circular to each section and by announcing on the notice Board. As there are 5 sections from A-E of B.Sc programme and 02 sections from A,B of B.C.A programme, they were allowed to attend two different sessions in room no one (Dr. Radhakrishnan Hall) and two (Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Hall) at the rate of two sections per room daily. Every day, the programme was started at 10:30 am in Room no 01, whereas with a gap of 1 hour in room no 02. The resource persons presented the information of their corresponding units in both sessions respectively.

The program on every day was started with a prayer song by the students and ended with the state song in a systematic way. On first day with the inauguration of the event, the introductory note was rendered by the Program co-ordinator Dr. Vidyashankar M.H. 


